Sustainability is a promise for future generations. As a company we strive to put sustainability first in everything we do, from product development to working environment.

A great bag doesn't have to take a huge toll on the planet. We always aim for our impact on the environment to be as small as possible, in every step of the process.

We use 100% organic cotton from small-scale farmers. The weave is tight and dense, resulting in a thick and heavy-duty material.

We're picky about our cotton. Choosing organic protects the farmers from hazardous chemicals and promotes local biodiversity.

Sandqvist requires responsible chemical management by our suppliers, ensuring that water is conserved at all steps of production. Steering clear of harmful chemicals means that less water is needed during production. It also means that we keep out those chemicals out of local water supplies.

Our recycled polyester gives a new lease of life to PET-bottles: a waste material that is not biodegradable. This reduces the climate impact of the material by 50%.

Our recycled polyester is made with consumer waste. A bag like Bernt can give new purpose to 30 (0,5L) PET-bottles, reducing the climate impact of the material by 50%.

Our staff regularly visit our suppliers to ensure good working conditions. In addition to this, external audits are commissioned to find potential improvements. We take great pride in maintaining a kind supply chain, with fair wages and safe work environments for everyone involved from sketch to finished bag.

Sandqvist has a strict chemical policy, setting requirements on chemicals used throughout the production process.

Pesticides and chemicals aren't good for you, our manufacturers, or the planet. That's why we avoid them as much as possible.
